*The 2011-2012 statistics reflect a new tracking method implemented by the Administrative Board in disciplinary cases. In previous years, all cases decided by the Board were recorded with just one vote. Beginning with the second term of the 2011-12 academic year, cases were recorded with multiple votes when the infraction was a violation of more than one policy in the Handbook. This change allowed the Board to more accurately capture the nuances of a specific infraction. The totals in blue reflect the number of cases decided by the Board while the subheadings reflect the number of votes.

**In 2010-2011, the statistics included three new categories of action: House Warning, Exclude and In Class Referral. While House Warnings were always reported to the Board, a change in Faculty Legislation provided the Board with two additional possible actions in cases involving academic integrity: Exclude and In Class Referral.

***Beginning in 2015-2016, the Administrative Board is no longer responsible for hearing cases of academic dishonesty. This chart includes statistics that bridge the transition; for example, the relieve from probation line indicates, for 2015-2016, those students who were relieved from disciplinary probation under the Board's jurisdiction, not those placed on probation by the Honor Council. The Harvard College Honor Council is the body now responsible for hearing concerns of academic dishonesty.
